Our organization's mission is help youth succeed in life by providing the opportunities to build relationships with themselves, peers, through assuring them that there is a finish line to their struggles. Therefore, to continue to remember how Dorothy lived her life in perseverance, and determination this scholarship is in place to give opportunity to high school seniors, prospective students, and students who are currently enrolled in a college or university who have been diagnosed with cancer.

Applicant Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant Must Live in the State of North Carolina
- Applicant Must Attach or Show Proof of Letter of Acceptance from College or University.
- Applicant Must Currently be a current High School Senior or Prospective College Student, or current Freshmen or Sophomore enrolled in a college or university
- Applicant Must Submit a 500-word essay on how the effect of their diagnosis has challenged their way of living.

List of Required Documents:

- Scholarship Application, filled completely
- The Applicant must submit an essay with a topic that explains their journey going through their diagnosis of cancer or disease. Applicant must also explain any strengths and, or weakness that were endured while going through the sickness. The Essay must not be less than 500 words.

- 2. Return a typed or neatly printed application to your high school guidance counselor by the deadline due date. This application is the first impression you will make upon those who award scholarships.
